
Principal's Report

MAPPEN is a well-structured and guided inquiry program that integrates many different key learning areas such as History, Geography, Science and Civics and Citizenship. Students will cover all the different themes over a two-year cycle. This term our theme is 'Identity'. MAPPEN currently runs every hour after lunch, excluding Fridays. During this time students will be split into three key learning groups – (prep-2, 3/4 and 5/6). We certainly are looking forward to showcasing the projects the come from this program.

This week has also been a big week for our grade 6 students as they have been working hard on their leadership speeches. They will have a chance to convince the school community about why they should be chosen for a leadership position during our school assembly this Friday. I am certainly looking forward to hearing what they have to say.






Mini Golf


REMINDER
